

## "Theatre in the Park" Summer Day Camp 2020: COVID-19 GUIDELINES & CHANGES

We are excited to re-open our Program as of Monday July 13, 2020! For the safety and wellbeing of all, please read the following guidelines and changes carefully.

As a safety precaution, if you or your Camper are experiencing any COVID symptoms please stay at home and advise us immediately. We want all our Campers, Counselors and families to stay healthy!

The following changes and procedures have been implemented into our daily schedule and preparation leading to our opening:

- Daily touchless temperature checks each morning for all Counselors and Campers
- Extended and staggered drop off and pick up times
- No before or aftercare available
- All Counselors must wear gloves and mask during sign in and sign out
- Parents/Guardians are also required to wear a mask during drop off/pick up for signing in/out
- Touchless sanitizer dispensers will be located inside and outside facilities
- Limit of 6 Campers per group and 1 Counselor
- No Campers under the age of 7 years
- Designated areas. This includes:
  - o Indoor and Outdoor space
  - o Washroom stalls & sinks
- Areas are sanitized 3x per day
- Washrooms are sanitized after each use (assigned washroom breaks)
- Individual space to keep personal belongings. We ask that your Camper packs minimal and only brings essentials which includes:
  - o Peanut free lunch
  - o Refillable water bottle
  - o Sunscreen
  - o Indoor/outdoor clothing
- No communal bins (craft, activity, sport or dress up)
- No 1-week Campers in a 2-week session
- Virtual performance/showcase at the end of 2-week Camp
- No water day
- No singing indoors (to keep with the health guidelines all singing must be done outdoors)

We ask that there is a limit of 1 parent/guardian present for drop off/pick up to limit the number of visitors and allow for more room to practice social distancing. We also ask that the parent/guardian responsible for drop off/pick up is well aware of our policies and procedures in place!

**\*\*If a Camper begins to show COVID symptoms while at Camp, they will be isolated immediately and the parent/guardian must agree for an immediate pick up.\*\***

Please let us know what time you are expecting to drop off and pick up during the allotted times of 8:30am-9:00am and 4:00pm-4:30pm. This will allow us to be well prepared and to practice social distancing!

Our focus is to provide a fun, safe and welcoming Theatre and Camp experience for all! We thank you for your patience and cooperation to make this happen.
